Dear Mayor Bagshaw,

The Legacy at Lake Jessamine HOA is now prepared to plant the replacement trees along Holden Avenue and on Jessamine Lane. I have included the aerial satellite view of both areas that shows where the prior trees were located and have also placed a legend on the attached.

On Jessamine Lane, Legacy HOA still has one tree on our property that needs to be removed and replaced with a tree that is acceptable as listed below to be planted near sidewalks/walls and underneath the power lines. I have indicated that tree on the attached picture.

On Jessamine Lane there is a tract that is Edgewood Property that I have identified that has a large clump of Oaks that are near our community wall and sidewalk that the City Arborist has already in his prior response advised needed to be removed as they pose an issue to the sidewalk, wall and are directly growing through the power line.

After researching the trees that are acceptable by the power company to be placed under the power lines and obtaining professional recommendations from several arborist and University Professors specializing in this field, the Legacy HOA Board has ruled out using the Burford Hollies we were originally considering as they are prone to disease. We have selected the Japanese Blueberry Tree to replace all the trees removed on Holden Ave and on Jessamine Lane. The size selected is 65 Gallon Trees that are currently at 12 feet tall. These trees are within the approved list for the power company and are able to be maintained to a height that will not interfere with the power lines above them. They also do not have an invasive root system that could damage sidewalks and or our walls. They are also not prone to disease and we are able to shape them as shown in the attached pictures.

Please advise if this request is sufficient for the Edgewood City Council and that the replacement project is acceptable to move forward as we have the trees and crew on standby ready to install.




