

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-07

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD,
FLORIDA AMENDING THE REPLACEMENT TREE
STOCK LIST CONTAINED IN SECTION 130-7 TO
INCLUDE THE JAPANESE BLUEBERRY TREE;
PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY,
CODIFICATION AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it appropriate to include the Japanese Blueberry Tree in the replacement tree stock list contained in the City's Tree Management and Protection Ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Replacement Tree Stock List contained in Section 130-7 of the City of Edgewood Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (note, underlined text indicates added text):

American beech	Pignut hickory
American elm; White elm	Pond cypress
American holly	Red bay
Bald cypress	Red buckeye
Basswood	Red maple
Black cherry	Sand live oak
Black gum	Scrub hickory
Bluejack oak	Scrub oak
Chickasaw plum	Slash pine
Chinese elm	Southern magnolia
Coast pignut hickory	Southern red cedar


SECTION 6: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and adoption.
