

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA AMENDING SECTION 2-49 RELATED TO SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR ALTERNATIVE METHODS OF NOTIFICATION TO COUNCIL MEMBERS OF SPECIAL MEETINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances currently does not allow for notice of special meetings to be mailed or emailed to members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is sufficient for notice of special meetings to be provided by mail, email or hand delivery.

SECTION 1. Chapter 2, "ADMINISTRATION," is hereby amended as follows (Note, Underlined words constitute the additions to the existing text of the Code of Ordinances, strikethroughs constitute deletions to the existing text and plain text is text that remains unchanged by this Ordinance):

Sec. 2-49. - Special meetings.

Whenever a special meeting shall be called, a summons or notice in writing signed by the mayor shall be ~~served upon~~ mailed, hand-delivered or emailed to each member of the council, either in person or by notice left at his place of residence, stating the date, hour and place of the meeting and the purpose for which such meeting is called, and no business shall be transacted thereat, except as is stated in the notice. In the event that service of notice of a special meeting is mailed to a member of the City Council, such mailing shall be posted at least three days prior to the date of the special meeting. In the event that service of notice of a special meeting is emailed or hand delivered to a member of the City Council, such notice shall be emailed or delivered at least twenty-four hours prior to the time of the of the special meeting.


SECTION 2: Codification: Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be codified and made part of the City of Edgewood Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3: Control: In the event of a conflict or conflicts between this ordinance and other ordinances, this ordinance controls.

SECTION 4: Severability: It is the intent of the City Council of the City of Edgewood, and is hereby provided, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.


SECTION 5: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and adoption.
