

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD,  
FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TREE REPLACEMENT STOCK  
LIST PURSUANT TO SECTION 130-7 OF THE CODE OF  
ORDINANCES**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Edgewood adopted Ordinance 2013-08 providing for adoption of a tree replacement stock list by resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA:**

Green ash	Sweet bay




Section 2. Conflict: Any and all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
