

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-03

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA,
AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF SURPLUS COMPUTER
EQUIPMENT TO THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE'S POLICE
DEPARTMENT, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS,
SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Edgewood has surplus computer equipment that no longer serves a useful function to the City;

WHEREAS, the City of Edgewood wishes to donate the computer equipment to the City of Belle Isle's Police Department, a government agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. The donation of surplus computer equipment listed on Exhibit "A", to the City of Belle Isle's Police Department is hereby approved in accordance with Florida Statutes §275.05.

Section 2. The Mayor and/or his designee are hereby authorized to execute all documents relating to this donation, and are hereby authorized to effectuate the transfer of these items.

Section 3. Conflict: Any and all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


