

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA, APPOINTING THE CITY CLERK OR DESIGNEE AS THE CLERK TO THE LOCAL HEARING OFFICER FOR RED LIGHT CAMERA INFRACTION HEARINGS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 62, ARTICLE IV OF THE EDGEWOOD CITY CODE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Edgewood adopted Ordinance 2013-03 expanding Chapter 62 of the Edgewood City Code, to include Article IV entitled the "Traffic Light Safety Act"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2013-03, and consistent with section 316.0083, Florida Statutes, the "Mark Wandall Traffic Safety Act", the City is required to designate an existing staff member to serve as the local hearing officer for red light camera infraction hearings; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2013-03.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Recitals: The following recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. Appointment: The City Council of the City of Edgewood hereby confirms the appointment of the City Clerk or **his/her designee** to function as the clerk to the local hearing officer for red light camera infraction hearings.

Section 3. Conflict: Any and all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 4. Severability: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereto.

Section 5. Effective Date: This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
