

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA, DECLARING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF SUCH SURPLUS EQUIPMENT, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Edgewood possesses certain equipment as described in Exhibit “A,” attached hereto and incorporated herein, that no longer serves a useful function to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Edgewood wishes to donate the surplus equipment to Puerto Rico to aid them in their recovery of the devastation caused by Hurricane Maria,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWOOD, FLORIDA:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of Edgewood declares the surplus equipment described in Exhibit “A” as surplus.
- Section 2. The City Council of the City of Edgewood has determined that it is appropriate to donate the surplus equipment described in Exhibit “A” to Puerto Rico pursuant to Florida Statutes §274.05.
- Section 3. The Mayor and/or his designee are hereby authorized to execute all documents relating to this donation and are hereby authorized to effectuate the transfer of the surplus equipment.
- Section 4. Conflict: Any and all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 5. Severability: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereto.
- Section 6. Effective Date: This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
